CCRTA Implementing Service Improvements Beginning November 1st

Four routes will see extended service hours on weekdays

(Corpus Christi, Texas) – Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority (CCRTA) will improve service for four popular routes, beginning November 1st. The routes will extend service to 10:00pm to better serve riders' needs. Scheduled service extensions include:

- Route 4 – Flour Bluff
- Route 12 – Hillcrest/Baldwin
- Route 34 – Robstown North
- Route 35 – Robstown South

The routes were selected for service increases based on equitability, accessibility, and ridership feedback. As part of CCRTA's Long-Range System Plan, there are plans to extend service for additional routes, but there is a need for additional Bus Operators.

“We're committed to serving the needs of our community, and it is our goal to provide expanded service within our ability. We continue to evaluate our resources on a daily basis to provide the best service possible. To extend service for additional routes, we will need more Bus Operators. I encourage anyone searching for a rewarding career to apply in-person or on our website,” said Derrick Majchszak, CCRTA's Chief Executive Officer.

CCRTA offers paid CDL training for oncoming Bus Operators, as well as big recruitment bonuses, competitive pay, excellent benefits, and tuition reimbursement. Paid training for a Bus Operator lasts approximately six to eight weeks and includes CDL training, driving and route preparation, customer service, safety and security protocols, and much more.

CCRTA has also extended service hours for B-Line Paratransit riders, with service now running until 11:00pm on weekdays and Saturdays. For reservation times, please contact 361-289-5881.
