CCRTA Implementing Comprehensive Service Improvements
Service Enhancements Effective on January 15th

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – A better ride awaits. As part of Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority’s continued efforts to improve service efficiency and accessibility, nine (9) routes will be improved upon, beginning January 15th. These improvements will increase service frequency, expand service on Sundays, or expand hours on weekdays with later evening trips. As part of CCRTA’s long-range system plan, the transportation system will continue to see developments.

Paid training for a Bus Operator lasts approximately six to eight weeks and includes CDL training, driving and route preparation, customer service, safety and security protocols, and much more.
